She was a graduate of Kempton-Cabery High School and St. Mary's School of Nursing. She received a bachelor of science degree from St. Francis University and her master's in nursing from Governors State University. Siawrys Sr., whom she married Oct. 17, 1964, in Cullom; one son and daughter-in-law, Robert J. 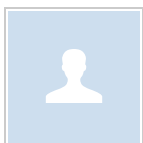

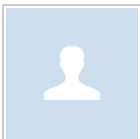
