She was born Aug. 29, 1911, in Beaverville, the daughter of Arthur and Mary Marion Regnier. She married Joseph Dressler Oct. 17, 1931, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. He died Dec. 15, 1953.

Widowed in her early forties with four children to raise, Jeannette rolled up her sleeves and went to work as a cook at Bradley Elementary School. She also worked for many years at Mortell Manufacturing and retired from there at age 65. She was a hard and conscientious worker on the job and at home, where she loved to keep everything in spic-and-span order and tend to her garden. She loved flowers and especially enjoyed being with, and cooking for, her family. She also enjoyed traveling and playing cards. She was a member of the CCW at her church and the Royal Neighbors of America.

Surviving are her four children: sons, Wayne (Joanne) Dressler, of Limestone, Gerald (Lila) Dressler, of North Port, Fla., Ronald (Patricia) Dressler, of Kankakee; and daughter, Joann (Paul) Neveau, of Phoenix, Ariz. She is also survived by nine grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren; and sisters, RoseMae Kaminsky and Marie Wallace, both of Kankakee, and Darlene Provancal, of Tinley Park.

She was preceded in death by her parents; five sisters, Evelyn Senesac, Stella Fournier, Dorine Hequet, Bernice Beland and Derillda Lawrence; four brothers, Lester, Paul, Donald and Arthur Jr.; and many nieces and nephews.
