Jeffrey Scott "Jeff" Ahlden, 61, of Bourbonnais, passed away on Thursday, August 28, 2025, at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee, Illinois.

Jeff was born January 5, 1964 in Kankakee, Illinois, to Lou Ann Clark. He began his career as a radio DJ before starting as a HVAC salesman at Home Furniture more than 25 years ago, where he eventually became a part owner. In addition, he owned and managed properties in the greater Bourbonnais area for over 20 years.

Jeff had a deep love of music and travel, especially cruising to destinations in the South. After his retirement in 2022, he split his time between Bourbonnais and his home in Florida, chasing the sun with his partner, Lori Weedon. A lifelong baseball fan, he especially loved cheering for the Chicago White Sox and rooting against the Cubs.
