



Jerome H. Arseneau

October 26, 1942 - December 11, 2015

Jerome H. Arseneau, 73, of Manteno, passed away on Friday (Dec. 11, 2015) at Presence Heritage Village in Kankakee, as a result of complications after suffering a stroke early last month.

He was born on Oct. 26, 1942, in Bourbonnais, the son of Willard and Hattie (Raymond) Arseneau.

Surviving are his wife, Victoria (Blackwell) Arseneau, of Manteno; sons from his first marriage, Timothy (Maria) Arseneau, of Bourbonnais, Michael (Maria Victoria) Arseneau, of Des Plaines, and Jerome (Carrie) Arseneau, of Manteno; daughter-in-law, Nicoele (Andrew, deceased); and step-children, Brian (Dee) Imrie and Kim (Grady) Maynard.
