She was also a member of Riverside Twigs and a charter member of the original American Lutheran Church, where she was active with Sarah's Circle and the ALCW organization. Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, Thomas and Paula Wasser of Bourbonnais, James and Carol Wasser of St. Anne; and four grandchildren. Deceased are one brother, Darwin Warthen; and one sister, Bernita Ginther.
