Joan J. Pierce, age 81, of Bourbonnais passed away Monday, December 19, 2022 at Riverside Miller Healthcare in Kankakee. She was born February 3, 1941 in Kankakee, the daughter of John & Martha (Rantz) Webster. Joan married Donald J. Pierce on August 5, 1961 at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Kankakee. He preceded her in death on January 14, 2018.

Joan's first employer was Armour Pharmaceutical. She ran a daycare out of her home for almost 40 years. She served 20 years as Bourbonnais Township Clerk, a four term, 16-year member of the BBCHS Board, and over 25 years as the Bourbonnais Village Plan Commission & Zoning Board of Appeals board member. She retired from the Planning Commission and was honored by the mayor and the Board in June of 2018. Joan was a Democratic Party Precinct Committee person for over 40 years and was a longtime member of the League of Women Voters. In 2016, she was honored as Senior Citizen of the year by the Daily Journal. Joan enjoyed cake decorating. Joan had also been a den mother for the Bourbonnais Cub Scout Pack 324

She was a parishioner of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley and served on the Art & Environment Committee and was a former member of the Parish Council.
