Joan Scanlon, age 86 of Herscher, died Tuesday, March 1, 2016 at her home surrounded by her loving family.

She was born Nov. 19, 1929 in Kankakee, IL to Thomas P. and Marie L. Onken Cleary. She married James L. Scanlon on April 19, 1952 at St. Patrick Church in Kankakee who precedes her in death on March 4, 2010.

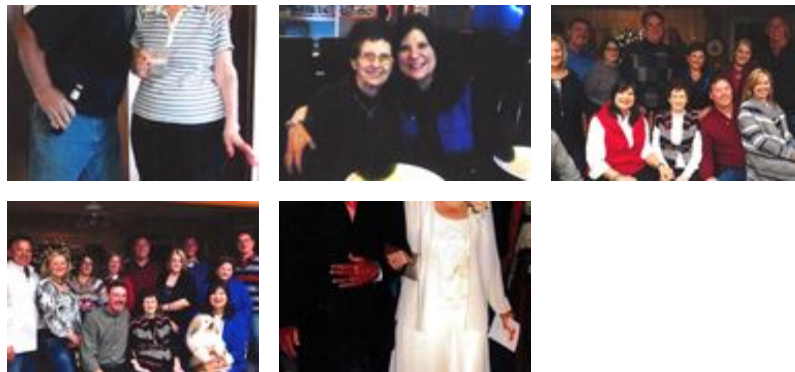

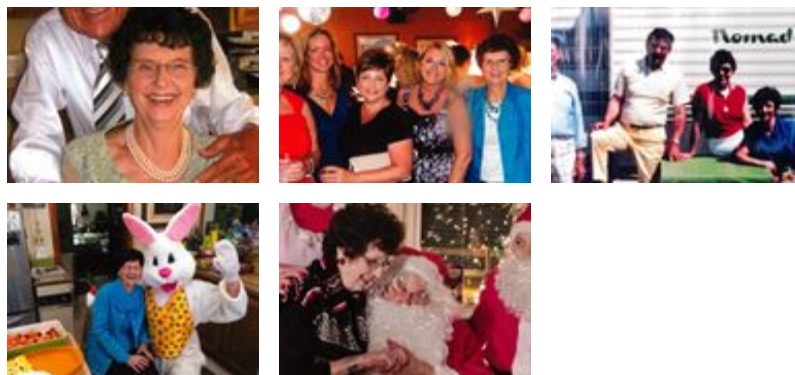

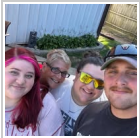
