Davis, whom she married July 2, 1949, at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Kankakee; five sons and four daughters-in-law, Bruce and Tina Davis of Bourbonnais, Mic and Michelle Davis of Mont Belvieu, Texas, Greg Davis, and Jim and Rhonda Davis, all of Bradley, Tom and Beth Davis of Frankfort; three daughters and two sons-in-law, Kathy Davis of South Hadley, Mass., Brenda and Dennis Dayhoff of Galena, Mo., Lynn and Mark Jennings of Bourbonnais; 18 grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren; one half
