Joanne Schnell, age 87, of Bourbonnais passed away Friday, May 24, 2024 at her home. She was born July 22, 1936 in Pisgah, IA, the daughter of Raymond & Doris (Laidler) Kline. Joanne married Lorne Schnell on September 25, 1960 in Turin, IA. He preceded her in death on October 12, 2000.

Joanne was an educator at Northeastern Clinton Central School, Kankakee Area Career Center, and Olivet Nazarene University. She was a Master Gardener.
