Jodi Anne (nee Ward) Wyatt, 68, of Martinton, died on Friday, November 21, 2025 at Riverside Hospital in Kankakee, Illinois.

Jodi was born on September 22, 1957, in Manteno, Illinois, to John and Pauline (née Gallois) Ward. She made Manteno her home for most of her life before moving to Martinton following her marriage to Charles “Chuck” Wyatt. Jodi and Chuck were married on October 15, 2015, at Wesley United Methodist Church in Bradley, Illinois.
