John D. "Jack" Calabria, 71, of Bourbonnais, died Friday (June 15, 2012) at his home. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, where funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday. The Rev. Joel Colbernaut will officiate.
