He loaded and fused bombs. He was a member of St. Joseph's Holy Name Society, the Bradley VFW, Bradley American Legion and the Moose Lodge. Surviving are his wife, the former Lucy Passentino of Bradley, whom he married April 28, 1946, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee; two daughters and sons-in-law, Frances and Roy Whitaker of Bradley, Lucinda and Jerry Struttmann of Bettendorf, Iowa; four grandchildren; two step grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; and one brother-in-law, Sam Passentino of Bradley. One daughter, Joanna Casino; two brothers, Carl J. Casino and Benny Casino; and one sister, Mary LeBran are deceased.
