John Hendron Sr. -- Bourbonnais John V. Hendron Sr., 101, of Bourbonnais, died Tuesday (Aug. 30, 2005) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 4-8 p.m. Friday at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. Graveside services will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday in the chapel at All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. Rev. Daniel Bult will officiate. Memorials may be made to the family wishes. Mr. Hendron was a former ATF agent. He retired from Snowite Laundry in Kankakee, where he had worked from 1933-1975. He worked at the Kankakee VFW until he was 91. He was born May 20, 1904, in Paducah, Ky., the son of Ebenizer and Lula Hendron. He was a member of the Kankakee Valley Family Church. He was involved in boxing, mostly as a trainer. He enjoyed gardening. Surviving are his wife, the former Viola Mae Friendt, whom he married Aug. 27, 1949, in Bradley; two sons and daughters-in-law, John Jr. and Bernice Hendron of Massachusetts, Robert and Barbara Hendron of Kankakee; one daughter and son-in-law, Marla Blanchette Rommel and Bob Rommel of Aurora; 10 grandchildren, 22 great-grandchildren and eight great-great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews. Deceased are one daughter, Lorraine LaFrance; one sister, Myrtle; four brothers, Everett, Elmer, Ansel and Marvin Hendron; and two grandsons, Scott and John LaFrance.
