John Harry Larson, 77, of Bradley, died Thursday (Dec. 25, 2008) in the emergency room at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 9:30 a.m. Tuesday until the 10:30 a.m. services at St. Paul Lutheran Church, Kankakee, where he was a member. The Rev. Christopher Sheets will officiate. Soucie, whom he married Dec. 21, 1952, at St. Paul Lutheran Church; one sister and brother-in-law, Irene and Alvin Carter of Bourbonnais; and several nieces and nephews. Deceased are one brother, Howard; and two sisters, Esther Ross and Sylvia Nickel.
