John Menig, 86, of Manteno, died Thursday (Nov. 10, 2011) at his home. Cremation rites have been accorded. Memorials visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Manteno. A memorial Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Manteno. The Rev. Al Heidecke will officiate.

He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Purple Heart. He was a graduate of Roosevelt University in Chicago.

Surviving are his wife, the former Irene Curtis, of Manteno, whom he married June 17, 1946, in Chicago; three sons and daughters-in-law, Thomas and Ofelia Menig, of Joliet, Bill and Terry Menig, of Peotone, and Mark and Denise Menig, of Minooka; three daughters and sons-in-law, Nancy and Vince Dyrek,

of Frankfort, Mary Therese and Mark Fazzini, of Homewood, and Jacqueline and John Burton, of Kerrville, Texas; 17 grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.
