John Trost, 66, of Kankakee, died Saturday (Feb. 23, 2008) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Friday at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Kankakee. The Rev. John Peeters and the Rev. Dennis Spies will officiate. Burial will be in Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery, Elwood. Memorials may be made to the family. Mr. Trost was a self-employed barber, owned and operated John's Barber Shop, and was 3rd Ward city alderman. He was born Aug. 3, 1941, in Kankakee, the son of Harold W. and Antoinette Amiot Trost. He had attended St. Patrick Catholic Church in Kankakee and St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. He graduated from Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School and Peoria Barber College. He enjoyed fishing and camping and was an avid hunter. Surviving are his wife, the former Sharon Wiemken, whom he married Aug. 20, 1988, in Kankakee; his children, Angela and Drew Haigh of Columbia, Mo., Kelly and Brian Romito of Bourbonnais, Julene and Greg Sobol of Swancea, Chad and Stephanie Dalton of Northfield, Ohio, Michelle and Don Goble of Langshire, England, Wendy Riberto and Josh Norton of Bradley; 13 grandchildren; three sisters and one brother-in-law, Cecilia Williams of Bourbonnais, Rose Mary and Vincent Spies of Ashkum, Joanne Duncan of Fort Worth, Texas; and one brother and sister-in-law, Edward and Maria Trost of Waxahatchie, Texas.
