Josef Kress -- Bradley Visitation for Josef Kress, 90, of Bradley and Mesa, Ariz., will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Bradley. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. He died Saturday (Nov. 3, 2007) at his home in Mesa. Mr. Kress retired from A.O. Smith Corporation and had also worked for Caterpillar in Joliet. He was born Jan. 27, 1917, in Rothamel, Germany, the son of Bartholomaeus and Anna Maria Kohlman Kress. His wife, the former Emilia Shell, whom he married Jan. 12, 1937, in Germany, died March 1, 1991. He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley, and Holy Cross Catholic Church in Mesa.
