Joseph Cotugno -- Bourbonnais Joseph W. Cotugno, 91, of Bourbonnais, formerly of Blue Island, died Friday (Nov. 25, 2005) at Riverside Medical Center. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. Monday until the 7 p.m. funeral Mass at St. George Catholic Church. Father Kenneth Yarno will officiate.
