Joseph J. Delmore, age 65, of Bourbonnais, passed away Saturday, September 18, 2021 at his home. He was born December 25, 1955 in Rochester, MN, the son of James “JP” & Mary Kiffe Delmore.

Joe married Amy Kirsch on September 16, 1983 at Maternity B.V.M. Catholic Church in Bourbonnais.

Starting in 1984, Joe had been a loan officer for Kankakee Federal Savings & Loans. He later worked for First of America Bank, Homestar Bank, where he spent most of his career, and then finished his career at Peoples Bank, retiring in 2020.

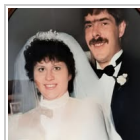

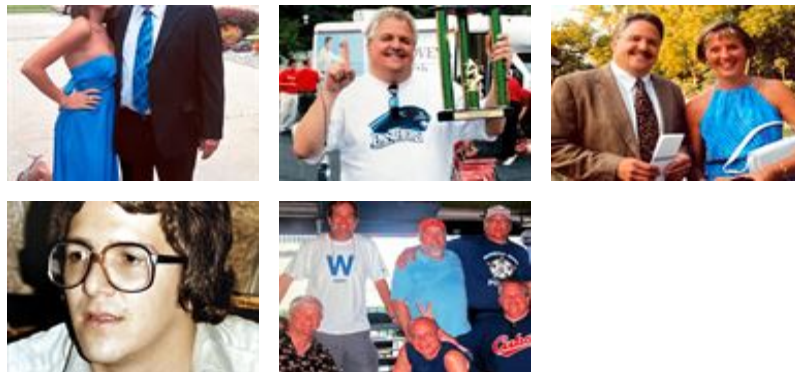

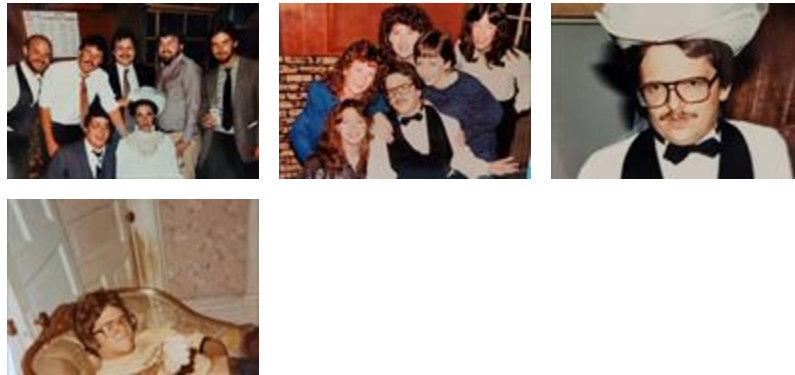
