Joseph V. Martino, age 83 of Kankakee passed away on Thursday, December 19, 2024 at Riverside Medical Center. Kankakee. He was born on March 26, 1941 at St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee and adopted by Sam and Philippine Martino of Kankakee.

Joe lived his life in Kankakee. He attended catholic schools and graduated from St. Patrick High School, Kankakee.
