Josephine “Jo” D. Ostrowski, 93, of Bourbonnais, passed away on Friday, March 11, 2016 in Bourbonnais. She was born on December 31, 1922 in Aroma Township to Robert and Rachel (McHattie) Stevenson. Josephine married Leo S. Ostrowski on April 12, 1952. He preceded her in death on November 30, 1988.

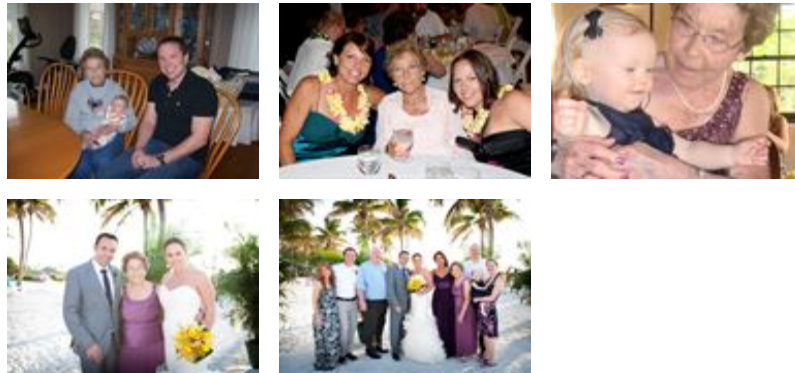
