I am so sorry for your loss, and all I can say is that it was a pleasure to know A9, and I will never forget him.

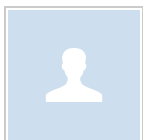

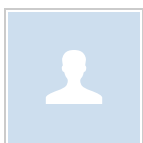
