



## Juliana M. Boudreau

May 21, 1930 - June 1, 2018

Juliana M. Boudreau, 88, of Kankakee passed away on Friday, June 1, 2018 at Miller Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center. She was born on May 21, 1930 in North Liberty, IA, the daughter of John Karl and Rose Marie (Marczak) Bisluk. Juliana married Andrew F. Boudreau on July 25, 1974. He preceded her in death on November 18, 1995.

Juliana was a 1948 graduate of Kankakee High School. She was a bank Teller at First Trust and Savings Bank. After 45 years of service, she retired from First America Bank in 1994.

She was an active member of St. Rose Church (St. John Paul II – Central), Ladies of St. Anne, and participated in the “Spirit of St. Rose”, was a member of the choir and served as a greeter. Juliana was also an active member of the Prayer Line.

She served over 25 years with the Knights of Columbus Ladies Auxiliary. She joined the Women of the Moose in 1978 and was very active and held many offices; she earned both the Academy of Friendship degree and the College of Regents degree, served as a senior regent, and sponsored over 160 members.

She is survived by two sons John R. (Deborah) Benoit of Bourbonnais and

James V. (Christine D.) Benoit of Maple Grove, MN; one daughter Jacqueline (John) Boomsma of St. Anne; stepchildren Douglas Boudreau of GA, Darryl (Sherrone) Boudreau of Abilene, TX, and Kathy Vernon of Lemoore, CA; her sisters Constance "Connie" Blanchette of Lake Havasu City, AZ and Mary Anne (Kenneth) Erzinger of Matteson; three grandchildren Mallory Boomsma, Ellen Boomsma and Allyson (Isaiah) Brown; and one great-grandchild Lauryn Brown. She is also survived by nine step grandchildren and seven step great-grandchildren.

Along with her husband, she was preceded in death by her parents, infant granddaughters Lisa and Leah Benoit, and a brother-in-law Virgil Blanchette.
