Justin M. Cyrier, age 88, of Bourbonnais, passed away Friday, August 20, 2021 at Lincolnwood Place in Lincolnwood.

He was born June 1, 1933 in Kankakee, the son of Alphonse & Edna Marcotte Cyrier.

He married Patricia Matthias on September 15, 1951. Justin & Patricia would have celebrated their 70th wedding anniversary this September.
