Kandie L. Power, age 75, of Bradley passed away Thursday, November 10, 2022 at her home. She was born April 26, 1947 in Kankakee, the daughter of Harold & Mary (Garrott) Ifland. Kandie married Joseph J. Power on October 18, 1966 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. He preceded her in death on March 23, 2018.

Kandie was a homemaker and had been employed by Options Center for Independent Living in Kankakee. She was a 1965 graduate of Kankakee High School. Kandie loved reading, shopping, traveling, and attending concerts and plays.

Surviving are two daughters and two sons-in-law, Cindy & Matthew St. Pierre of Bourbonnais and Amy & Jeremy Jeck of Bradley; one brother and sister-in-law, Lee & Pam Ifland of Aroma Park; three grandchildren, Isabella, Jackson, and Libby; and her guide dog, Echo. In addition to her husband, Joseph J. Power, Kandie is preceded in death by her parents and two previous guide dogs, Cindy & Kylie.

Cremation rites have been accorded. A memorial visitation will be held from 1 p.m. until the time of the 3 p.m. memorial service on Saturday, November 26, 2022 at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. 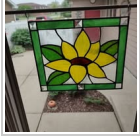
