



## Kathe Misevic

September 24, 1921 - December 24, 2016

Kathe Misevic, age 95, of Kankakee, passed away Saturday, December 24, 2016 at Presence Heritage Village in Kankakee.

She was born September 24, 1921 in Lundsburg, Germany, the daughter of Ernest & Gertrude Holz Hoettermann.

Kathe married Gabriel Misevic M.D. on April 12, 1952 in Elgin. He preceded her in death August 11, 2011.

Kathe had been raised and educated in Germany. She had been a homemaker. Kathe was past president of the Kankakee County Medical Auxillary. She was a member of the Women's Club of Kankakee. For 15 years, Kathe had worked as a translator at the Germany Consulate in Chicago.

Surviving are two nephews, Raimundas & Jurate Stulpinas and Balys & Jurate Stulpinas, all of Lithuania; her caregiver and friend for the past four years, Donna Zomick.

In addition to her husband, she is also preceded in death by her parents; one brother; and one sister.

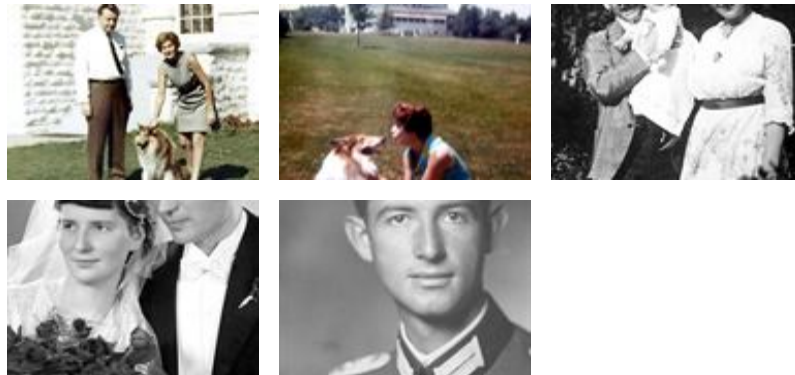
