Kathleen Hynek -- Bourbonnais Kathleen "Kathy" J. Hynek, 53, of Bourbonnais, died suddenly Tuesday (Dec. 12, 2006), at her home. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, and from 10 a.m. Saturday at Calvary Bible Church in Bourbonnais until the 11 a.m. funeral service. Mrs. Hynek was a part-time registered nurse at Riverside Medical Center and baby-sat in her home. She was born Dec. 30, 1952, in Hillsboro, Wis., the daughter of Raymond and Dorothy Herbeck Stanek. She received her B.S.N. from Viterbo University in LaCrosse, Wis. She was very active in her church and volunteered a lot. She was a former member of the Christian Women's Club and enjoyed Bible study groups, reading and spending time with her granddaughters, Addie and Kate. Surviving are her husband, Randall Hynek, whom she married June 29, 1974, in Hillsboro, Wis.; two daughters and one son-in-law, April and Steve Langelett of Bourbonnais, Julie Hynek of Bourbonnais and fianc Scott Owen of Crestwood; one granddaughter, Addie, and a grandchild due in March; mother, Dorothy Stanek of Wonewok, Wis.; three sisters and brothers-in-law, Ramona and Cal VanKirk of Milton, Wis., Janet Stanek and Charlie Hickenbottom of Wenatchee, Wash., Kris and John Pastor of Edina, Minn.; two brothers and three sisters-in-law, Mike and Nancy Stanek of Wonewok,
