Kathy J. Demarah, 56, of Bourbonnais, died Saturday (March 21, 2009) at home surrounded by her family. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Wednesday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church, Bourbonnais, where she was a member. The Rev. Richard Pighini will officiate. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley, Special Olympics or Children's Cancer Research. Mrs. Demarah was a homemaker, wife and mother. She was born June 25, 1952, in Kankakee, the daughter of Robert and Ellen Larsen Goselin. 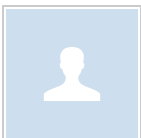

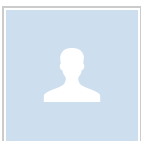

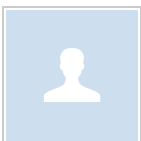
