Kevin C. Clancy, age 62, of Kankakee passed away Tuesday, October 26, 2021 at his home. He was born April 13, 1959 in Kankakee, the son of Richard L. "Dick" & Marlene A. (Nolte) Clancy. Kevin married Vicki St. Aubin-Benoche on October 20, 2018 in Kankakee.

Kevin was a graduate of St. Patrick Grade School, Bishop McNamara High School, and Eastern Illinois University.
