October 31, 1954 - February 4, 2019

Kim Dee Kammann, 64, of Chicago, formerly of Kankakee, passed away on Monday, February 4, 2019 in Bourbonnais. He was born on October 31, 1954 in Garrett, IN, the son of Richard B. and Rose Emma Conklin Kammann.

Kim was a veteran of the United States Air Force having served from 1973 until 1977 and the United States Navy having served from 1978 until 1986. He was the Vice Commander of VFW Post 9961 in Bourbonnais. He was a founding member of the Forgotten Veterans Band. The band released the CD "Sounds of Freedom", which was a musical tribute to Vietnam veterans and for which he wrote the song "58,000 Names on the Wall". Kim was the former manager of Pizza by Marchelloni. He was also an assistant manager for a hotel in Kankakee. He was a member of the Salvation Army Church in Kankakee.

Kim is survived by his mother, Rose Kammann; one son, Kaelan Patrick Kammann; two daughters and one son-in-law, Krystle Beal (Joshua) Hallas, of Santee, CA and Kylie Rose Kammann, of Bourbonnais; two grandchildren; one sister and one brother-in-law, Kathryn Lynn (Bodie) Weiss, of Wichita, KS; two brothers and two sisters-in-law, Kent B. (Tracey) Kammann, of Plainfield and his twin, Kevin (Marian) Kammann, of La Mesa, CA.

He was preceded in death by his father, Richard B. Kammann.

Visitation will be held from 4:00 pm until the time of the 7:00 pm funeral service on Monday, February 18, 2019 at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. Cremation rites will be accorded following the service. Inurnment will be held at a later date at Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery in Elwood.
