Kurt L. Berghouse, 55, of Kankakee, passed away on Tuesday, February 7, 2017 at Riverside Medical Center, surrounded by his friends and family. He was born on March 28, 1961, in Kankakee, to Richard and Irma Jean Kirchner Berghouse. Kurt married Martine C. Grant on February 4, 1989 at St. Martin of Tours Church.

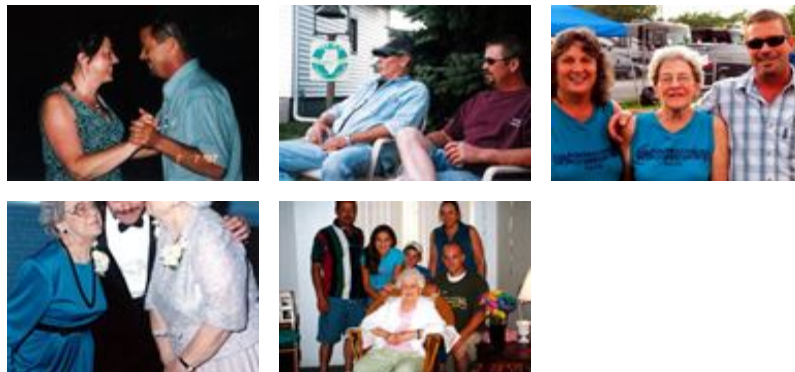
