Larry G. Caraway, 74, of Kankakee, passed away Saturday (April 12, 2014) at his home.

He was born June 2, 1939, in Eldorado, Ill., the son of Jethro and Mary Canno Caraway. He married Peggy L. Naese in Sept. 2008 in Kankakee.

Larry was the owner and operator of Larry's Imports for 32 years in Kankakee and a member of the Road Chasers Club, a Mason and a member of the Manteno Phantom Harley Owners Chapter.
