April 17, 1917 - January 4, 2009

Laura Luella Duby, 91, of St. Anne, was taken to our Lord on the morning of Jan. 4, 2009. She was born in western Pennsylvania on April 17, 1917 to Richard and Mary (Hedglin) Shafer. She was united in marriage to Melvin Duby Jan. 1, 1946, who precedes her in death. Laura started teaching school in Pennsylvania before she moved to Illinois to teach in the one-room schoolhouses (Scott and Pallisard) west of St. Anne. She retired from teaching in the spring of 1985 from St. Anne Grade School. She was an enthusiastic educator of nature and a great lover of the outdoors. She was a Brownie leader and 4-H Club leader; a member of the West St. Anne Home Extension, the National Audubon Society, the Illinois Retired Teachers Association; and a member of the First Presbyterian Church of St. Anne and a Sunday school teacher.
