Lawrence D. "Larry" DuMontelle, 31, of St. Anne, passed away Monday (July 22, 2013). 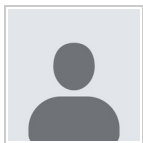

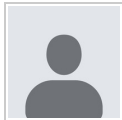
