Mr. Dupuis was a retired self-employed furniture repairman. He had also worked for Lassers Furniture for 25 years. He was born Oct. 26, 1926, in Kankakee, the son of Alfred and Hilda Jensen Dupuis. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy, serving during World War II on a destroyer in the Pacific Theatre of Operations. He was a former member of the Elks and enjoyed bowling. Surviving are his wife, the former Patricia Anderson, of Bradley, whom he married Aug. 9, 1947, at St. Mary Catholic Church, Kankakee; two sons, Gary Dupuis of Westchester, Jeffrey Dupuis of Bourbonnais; one daughter, Diana Meade of Bourbonnais; six grandchildren; and one sister, Norma Roe of Bradley. One infant brother, Ronald, is deceased.
