Lebert L. Mercier, 77, of St. Anne, passed away Sunday (April 13, 2014) at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee.

He was born May 14, 1936, in Kankakee, the son of Leo and Libbie Lebert Mercier. Lebert married Marilyn DeYoung on Jan. 17, 1958 at First Reformed Church of Wichert.

Lebert served his country with the U.S. Army and was an active farmer in the St. Anne area. He was a member of First Reformed Church of Wichert, a Sunday School teacher, an elder at the church and very active in Youth for Christ for 35 years, including serving as president. He served as the drainage commissioner for Iroquois County and was named Farmer of the Year in 1995.

He was preceded in death by his parents; and one sister, Louise Pearson.

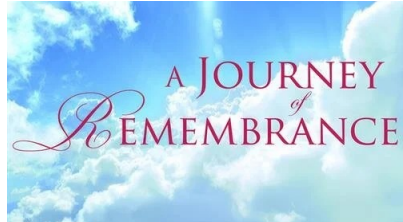
