Leo A. Klonowski, 94, of Bourbonnais, passed away Friday (July 24, 2015) at Miller Health Care Center in Kankakee.

He was born May 24, 1921, in Kankakee, the son of Bruno and Caroline Plecha Klonowski. Leo married Doris M. Hertzberg on Sept. 6, 1947, in St. Stanislaus Church in Kankakee.

Mr. Klonowski served with the U.S. Navy during World War II.

He retired from City National Bank after 36 years of service, was an employee of Kroehler Manufacturing, past president of Local 235 Upholsterers International Union, a former City of Kankakee First Ward Alderman, one of the organizers of the Northside Athletic Club, a former baseball and softball player and an umpire.

Surviving are his wife, of Bourbonnais; one son and daughter-in-law, Michael and Renee Klonowski, of Bourbonnais; one daughter and son-in-law, Patricia and Randy Rewerts, of Bourbonnais; a brother and sister-in-law, Jerome and Patricia Klonowski, of Kankakee; three grandchildren, Kyle and Laura (Longtin) Rewerts, Nick and Molly (Rewerts) Saathoff, and Brett Klonowski; and three great-grandchildren, Harper and Calvin Rewerts, and Nolan Saathoff.
