Leonard L. Flock, age 77, of Limestone, passed away on Thursday, December 23, 2021 at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee. He was born on January 20, 1944, in Paris, AR, the son of James and Ruby (Berry) Flock. He married Janice Smith on February 12, 1966 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Bradley.
