Leonard Kibbons -- Bourbonnais Visitation for Leonard E. Kibbons, 87, of Bourbonnais, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday. Smith in 1977, after 37 years of service. He was born Aug. 17, 1919, in St. Anne, the son of Elmon and Margaret Tatro Kibbons. He served during World War II in the U.S. Navy.
