Leonel C. Fritz, 65, of St. Charles, formerly of Bonfield, died Wednesday (March 5, 2008) at his home after a 4 1/2-year battle with cancer. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday at St. John Neumann Church in St. Charles and from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, 295 Main St. NW, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Tuesday at St. James the Apostle Church, Irwin. Interment will be in St. James the Apostle Cemetery. Memorials may be made to the Michael Fritz Trust. Mr. Fritz was employed at Joliet Avionics Air Center for 31 years, where he was a quality control manager. He was born Jan. 23, 1943, the son of Aloysius and Agnes Girard Fritz. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force and remained active in the field of aviation the rest of his life. He was a member of St. John Neumann Church in St. Charles, where he was a founding member and usher. Mr. Fritz had an approach at DuPage Airport named for him. Surviving are his wife, the former Virginia M. O'Connor, of St. Charles, whom he married April 4, 1964, at St. James the Apostle Church; four sons and three daughters-in-law, Carl and Heidi Fritz of Denver, Colo., Timothy and Gina Fritz of West Chicago, Matthew and Traci Fritz of Joliet, Michael Fritz of St. Charles; six grandchildren, Colin, Samuel, Molly, Wyatt, Elijah and Amelia Fritz; one sister and brother-in-law, Donna and Jerry Bernicky of Limestone; four brothers and three sisters-in-law, including his twin brother, Leon and Terry Fritz, Joseph and Carol Fritz, all of Bradley, John and Gloria Fritz of Hedgesville, W.Va., and Robert Fritz of Winter Park, Fla.
