Lionel G. Bouchard, 81, of Kankakee, died Saturday (Dec. 25, 2004) at Riverside Medical Center. Visitation will be from 4-8 p.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, West Kankakee, where services will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday. Rev. Dennis Settles will officiate. Burial will be in St. George Cemetery. Memorials may be made to the American Red Cross. Mr. Bouchard was an accounting supervisor at General Foods Corp., retiring after 35 years of service. He was born Dec. 9, 1923, in Ganeer Township, the son of Amedee and Alexia Grant Bouchard. His parents are deceased. Surviving are his wife, the former Pauline E. Cook, whom he married June 19, 1947, at St. Patrick's Catholic Church; two sons and one daughter-in-law, Jeff and Kathy Bouchard of Bourbonnais, Mark Bouchard of Melrose Park; one brother, Francis X. Bouchard of McAllen, Texas; two grandchildren, Jennifer Bouchard and Chris Bouchard; and two great-grandchildren, Haley Meyer and Chase Jones. One sister, Opal Powell, is deceased. He attended Gallagher Business school. Mr. Bouchard served in the U.S. Army during World War II with the Corps of Engineers in France, Germany, Panama, New Guinea and the Philippines. He was a volunteer for the American Red Cross, where he was a former treasurer. Mr. Bouchard was a member of St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church, where he was a former usher. He was also a member of the Kankakee American Legion Post 85 and the Moose.
