



## Llewellyn "Lew" Rogers

February 14, 1935 - August 18, 2015

Llewellyn "Lew" Rogers, 80, of Bourbonnais passed away on Tuesday, August 18, 2015 at Presence Our Lady of Victory. He was born February 14, 1935 to Harry and Edith Ely Rogers in Galesburg, IL. Lew married Ann Begler on December 29, 1956.
