Lois M. Minerick, age 88, of Glenview, former Kankakee and Bourbonnais resident, passed away Saturday, May 27, 2023 at Chestnut Square at the Glen in Glenview. She was born July 16, 1934 in Kankakee, the daughter of Glenn & Helen (Warren) Maxfield. Lois married John Minerick on October 24, 1987 in Bradley. He preceded her in death on April 26, 2013.

Lois was a retired Administrative Assistant and District Treasurer for Bradley Elementary School District. She was a graduate of Kankakee High School and had attended Illinois State University. Lois served as Past President of the Kankakee Emblem Club, Past National President of the Supreme Emblem Club of the USA, organizer and Charter President of the Kankakee County Office Personnel, Lifetime member of the Illinois & National Education Office Professionals, and Past President of Illinois Association of Educational Office Personnel.
