Lola V. McMullen, 93, of Kankakee, died Saturday (Sept. 29, 2012) at her home. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, and from 10 a.m. Wednesday at Trinity United Methodist Church, Kankakee, until the 11 a.m. funeral services.
