She was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church, where she served as a Eucharistic Minister. She was a volunteer at St. Mary's Gift Shop for 15 years. She accumulated 7,684 volunteer hours at St. Mary's. She was a member of the Tuesday Book Review, the Kankakee Historical Society, two bridge clubs and the Elks Golf Club. She played saxophone in various dance bands in the area and enjoyed golfing. Surviving are one daughter and son-in-law, Donna and Richard Halbin of Bluford; one sister and brother-in-law, Mable and Francis Michaels of Bradley; four grandchildren, Frederick (Virginia) Halbin, Timothy (Chelsea) Halbin, Jeffrey (Brenda) Halbin, Kathleen Segretario; 16 great-grandchildren and four great-great-grandchildren. Deceased are her parents and one brother, Lyle Bertrand.
