Lorraine Margaret (Richard) Dandelles, 86, of Kankakee, passed away Wednesday (Nov. 17, 2010) at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday at Annunciation Greek Orthodox Church in Kankakee. Lorraine loved to read and knit, was an avid bowler and an epicurean cook, having attended Francois Pope School of Cooking. Through her thoughtful handwritten cards and letters, Lorraine kept in touch with relatives and friends throughout the year. She was loved and appreciated by many, far and wide. Lorraine is survived by her husband, Harry; two sons, Harry Gus and Barbara, of Tulsa, Okla., and Tom and Eileen, of Kankakee; and their children and
