Louis Jamnik -- Bradley Visitation for Louis V. Jamnik, 76, of Bradley, will be from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. today at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Wednesday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. Burial will be in Mt. Calvary Cemetery. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley or to St. Joseph Grade School. He died Friday (Aug. 31, 2007) at his home, following an extended illness. Mr. Jamnik worked over 37 years for the U.S. Postal Service, retiring as Postmaster in Bradley. He also worked many years with Clancy-Gernon Funeral Homes and had been a driver for Peddinghaus Corp. He was born Jan. 27, 1931, in Bradley, the son of Joseph and Anna Rozman Jamnik. He served in the U.S. Navy on the USS Bataan aircraft carrier and was a member of the Bradley VFW and American Legion. He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley and the Holy Name Society. He served on the village of Bradley Planning Commission. He enjoyed sports, especially the Cubs; taking walks on the Perry Farm; and enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren. Surviving are his wife, the former Carol G. Jensen, whom he married Aug. 17, 1957, at Maternity BVM Catholic Church; one daughter and son-in-law, Therese and Robert Grace of Bourbonnais; three grandsons and one granddaughter, Austin Grace of Ocala, Fla., Tyler and Nolan Grace of Bourbonnais, Allison Jamnik of Casselberry, Fla.; and two brothers and sisters-in-law, Tony and Beverly Jamnik of St. Anne, Elmer and Nancy Jamnik of Joliet; three sisters-in-law and one brother-

in-law, Marge Kroesch of Bonfield, Patricia and Tom Herrman of Arlington Heights, and Laura Jensen of Buckingham. His parents; and two sons, John Jamnik and Mark Jamnik (in infancy), are deceased.

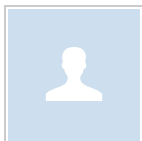

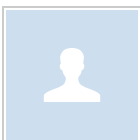
