



## Luben Antonoff

December 19, 1910 - September 10, 2007

Luben B. Antonoff, 96, of Manteno, died Monday (Sept. 10, 2007) at the Illinois Veterans Home at Manteno. Visitation will be from 9 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Manteno. A funeral Mass will follow at 11 a.m. at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Manteno, where he was a member. Rev. Albert Heidecke will officiate. Cremation rites will be accorded. Inurnment will be in Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery, Elwood, and Holy Cross Cemetery, Calumet City. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to the Illinois Veterans Home at Manteno or to Hospice of Kankakee Valley. Mr. Antonoff was a master barber. He owned/operated various shops on the south side of Chicago for many years. He was born Dec. 19, 1910, in Bulgaria, the son of Ambrose and Martina A. Draganova Antonoff. His wife, the former Anna Mannarino, whom he married June 2, 1936, in Chicago, died Aug. 30, 1998. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and was a member of the Calumet City American Legion. He had written his life story and enjoyed golf, tennis, and playing checkers and pinochle. Surviving are two daughters and sons-in-law, Martina and Joseph McDermott, Linda and R.H. Lison, all of Manteno; five grandchildren, 10 great-grandchildren, and three great-great-grandchildren. One son, Luben B. Antonoff Jr., is deceased.
