



## Lucille R. "Lucy" Etzel

August 9, 1951 - September 19, 2024

Lucille R. "Lucy" Etzel, age 73 of Bourbonnais passed away on Thursday, September 19, 2024, at her home surrounded by her family after a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer. She was born on August 9, 1951 in Kankakee, the daughter of Joseph A. and Reva (Ditzler) Hebert-Sutherland. Lucille married William G. Etzel on June 20, 1970, at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Kankakee.

Lucille was a retired employee of Bradley Bourbonnais Community High School. Lucille also ran her own daycare business. She volunteered at Maternity Food Pantry and Center of Hope Food Pantry.

Lucille enjoyed gardening, jigsaw puzzles, and traveling. She lived a life full of faith in God and loved spending time with her family and friends.

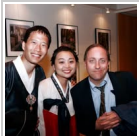
