C. Luella Fecke, age 97 of Kankakee formerly of Bonfield died Wednesday, Oct. 14, 2015 at Riverside Hospital, Kankakee, IL. Luella also served as a local 4-H leader for many years. In addition, and for more than 50 years, Luella was the primary caregiver for her handicapped sister, Fern.
